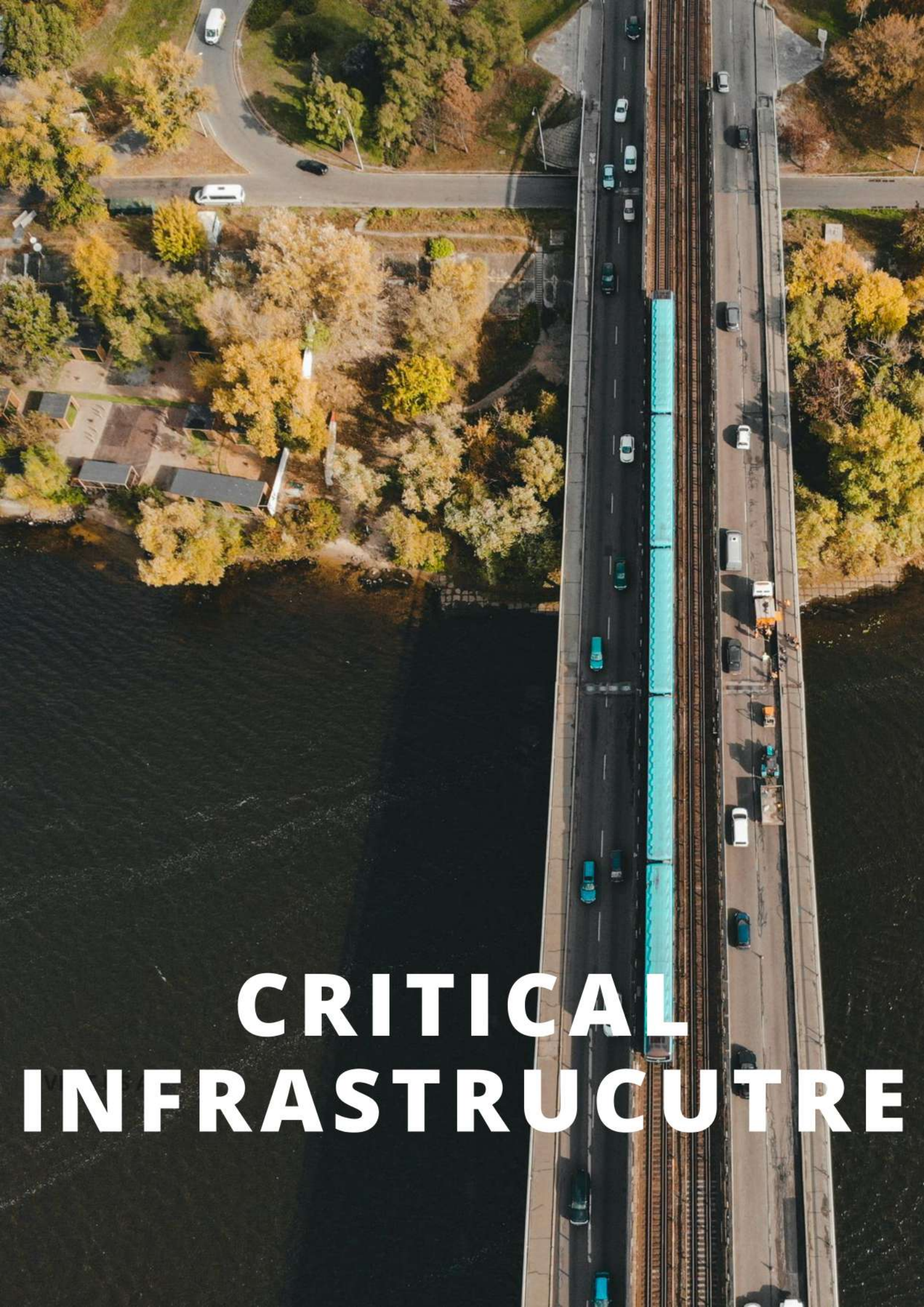

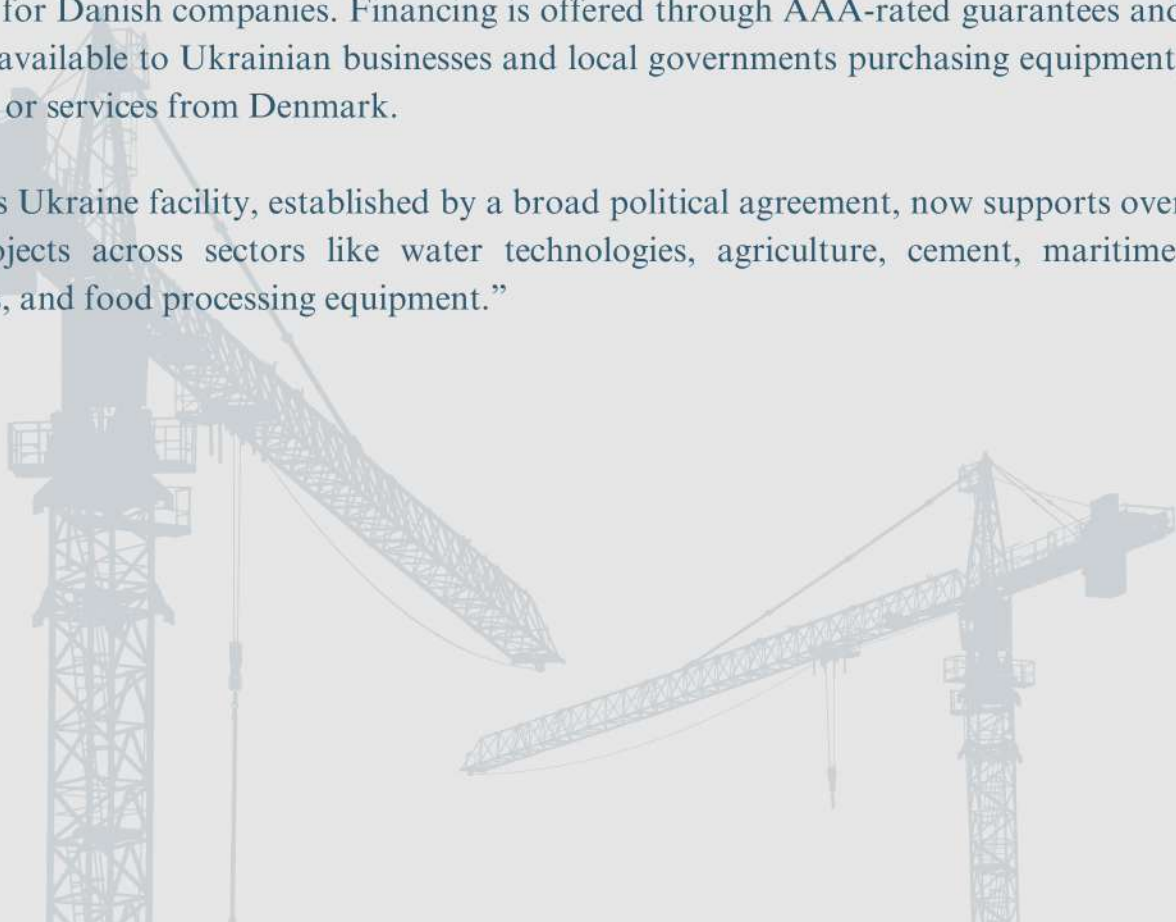


"EIFO, Denmark's Export Credit Agency, provides financing on commercial and semi-commercial terms to support exports and investments in Ukraine, helping to rebuild critical infrastructure and develop the private sector.

Private Ukrainian companies can access financing to buy Danish exports and cover project costs, while public institutions receive financing with a 40% grant. EIFO also mitigates risks for Danish exporters, including during the construction phase.

With a total capacity of EUR 375 million (EUR 268 million for private buyers and EUR 107 million for public buyers), EIFO backs Ukrainian reconstruction and secures orders for Danish companies. Financing is offered through AAA-rated guarantees and loans, available to Ukrainian businesses and local governments purchasing equipment, goods, or services from Denmark.

EIFO's Ukraine facility, established by a broad political agreement, now supports over 20 projects across sectors like water technologies, agriculture, cement, maritime, textiles, and food processing equipment."
