Healthcare sector - Romania

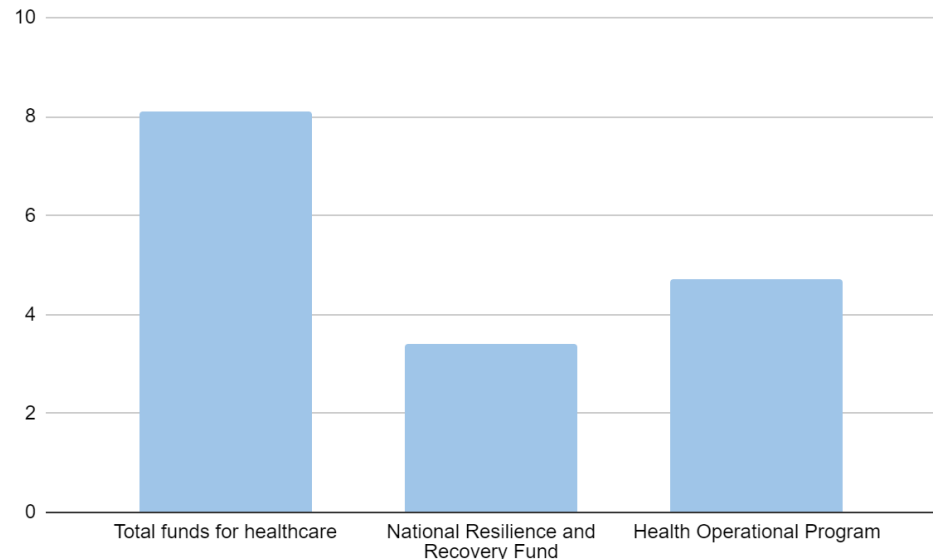
- Significant socioeconomic inequalities as well as substantial deficiencies in health service delivery
- The health system is based on a Social Health Insurance (SHI) model
- Romania registers one of the lowest shares of GDP allocated to healthcare in the European Union: 5.7%
- Health spending in Romania is the lowest in the EU, both on a per capita basis (EUR 1 029, EU average EUR 2 884) and as a proportion of GDP (5 %, EU 9.8 %)
- Romanian health system suffering from shortages of doctors and nurses. In 2017, there were 2.9 practicing doctors per 1 000 people, the third lowest figure in the EU (EU average 3.6), and 6.7 nurses per 1 000 people (EU average 8.5)



Healthcare sector - Romania

Romania will invest **EUR 3.4 billion** for healthcare sector based on the proposed National Resilience and Recovery plan

The Health Operational Program 2021-2027 shows a **EUR 4.7 billion**



Investment plans

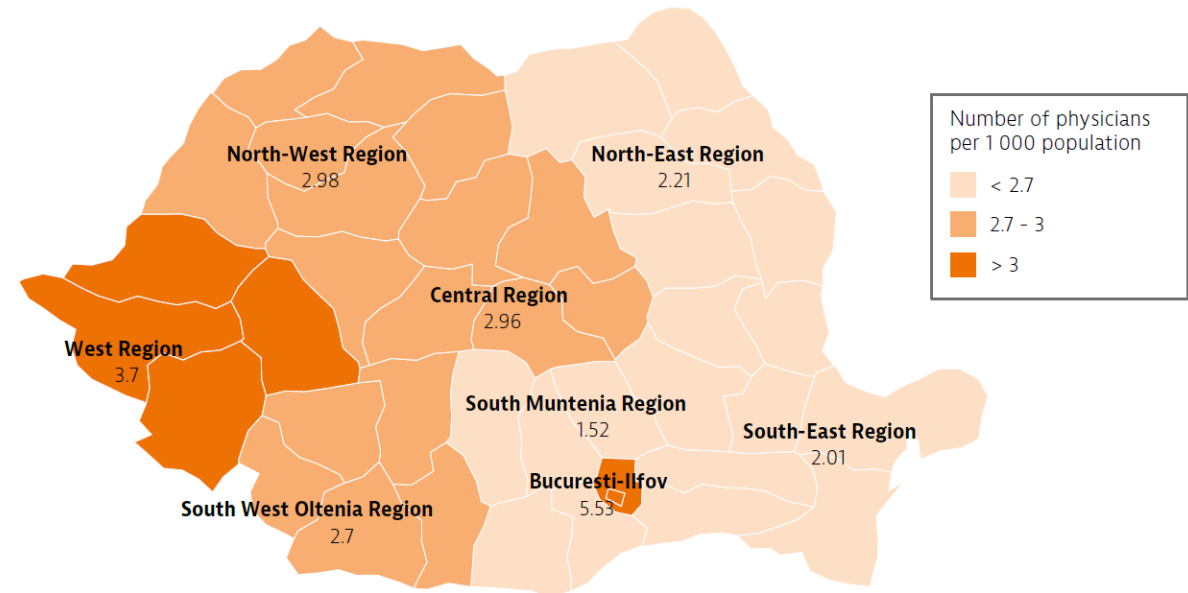
- modernization of 2000 general practices with screening equipment
- building and rehabilitation of 200 medical centers
- rehabilitation and equipment for 100 care centers

Priorities

- Construction of 3 regional hospitals
- Rehabilitation of hospitals
- Modernization of hospitals and general practices with medical equipment
- Digitalization of the medical system
- Upskillig the labor force

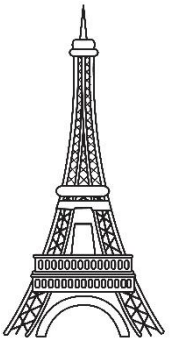

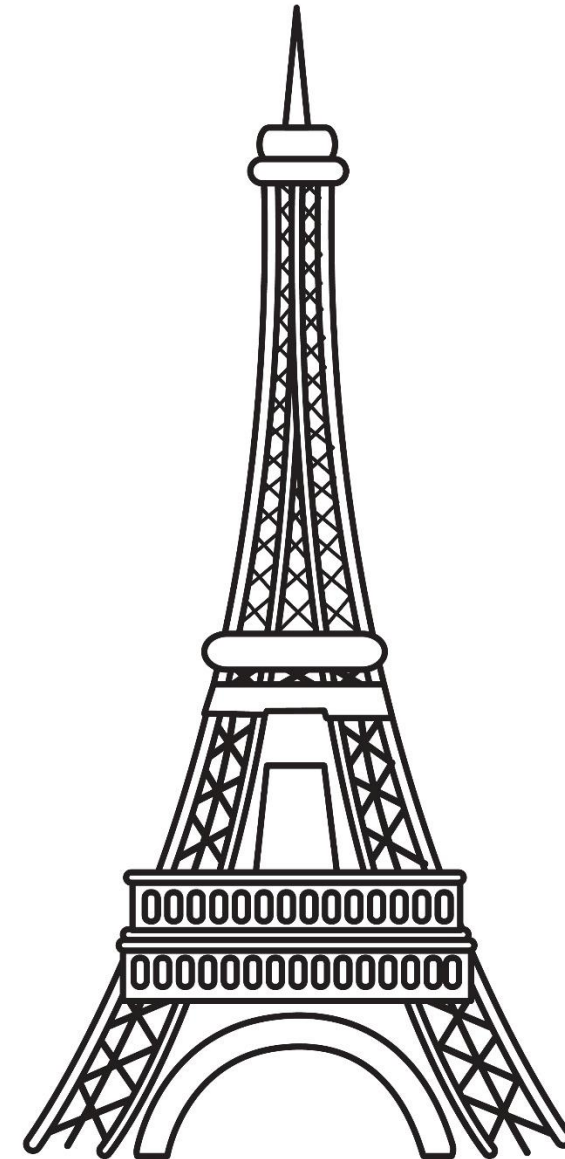
Funds managed in 3 steps:

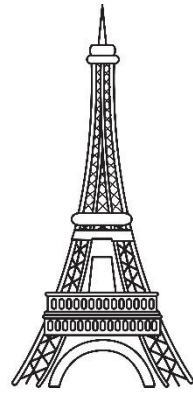
