The Confederation of Danish Industry (DI) together with the Trade Council of Denmark, Taipei, and with Food Nation as branding partner are organizing a food, beverages and agri business delegation to Taipei in Taiwan.

AGRI BUSINESS - THREE DAYS AT LIVESTOCK TAIWAN

Taiwan pig production industry is at a turning point, expecting to be transformed from polluted and low productivity to modern and sustainable production. In October 2020, the Taiwan Government announced a coming four-year budget of TWD 12.96 billion equivalent to DKK 2.855 billion allocated for modernization of pig production and pig slaughterhouses, including the introduction of HACCP standards to pig slaughterhouses. This will be the biggest initiative and the largest budget amount to support the transformation of pig industry.

FOOD SERVICE, RETAIL AND FOOD PROCESSING IN TAIWAN

Food safety is the top priority of any food business in Taiwan and from 2021 all meat products will be labelled with country of origin as a result of the open market access to American pork and beef containing ractopamine. There is a rise in fine dining and the consumers are more willing to pay for quality. The demand for bakery, confectionary and milk has increased in proportion to the coffee consumption.

Food retail is estimated at US\$38.8 billion, food service industry at US\$26.2 billion and the food processing industry at US\$19.9 billion.
