## Danish Energy Transition Initiative

In 2021, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Climate, Energy and Utilities launched the Danish Energy Transition Initiative (DETI). The initiative will focus on short term but intensive collaboration about green transition with developing countries. Initially the initiative will focus on Brazil, Columbia and Pakistan. The focus of collaboration is energy planning and offshore wind in Brazil, offshore wind and energy efficiency in Columbia and energy planning and promotion of renewable energy and energy efficiency in Pakistan.
